Background

The oncology high-risk screening and genetics clinic at Valley Medical Center in Renton, Washington, used a paper-based process for the initial implementation of their high-risk program.

The Challenge

A large amount of patient information was collected on paper forms, making it difficult for staff to process the information and decide next steps for the patient in a timely manner.

The center's genetic services operated below service capacity, because no formal process was in place to bring screened high-risk patients through to counseling consistently.

The paper questionnaire was complex and cumbersome. Patients had trouble filling out "multi-segmented" questions, and the techs had to evaluate paper forms based on an everchanging set of guidelines.

The Solution


Valley Medical Center replaced its paper process with CancerIQ. The center now has an automated, systematic screening process that identifies all patients according to the latest NCCN guidelines. The electronic system created a patient-friendly questionnaire, removing "multi-segmented" questions, which helps improve the accuracy of the patient's data entry.

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The Results


Streamlined Workflow
